Well your SDHS Cavers are doing very well.

Cavers Football

If you have not heard, your Cavers varsity football team not only won the City

League Championship, the SD CIF Div 4 Championship, Southern Calif. CIF Regional Championship but won the CIF Div. 5 State Championship.

To win that championship your Cavers had to travel to Colfax, Calif which is approximately 1 hour north of Sacramento. Facing 44-degree weather and being the only high school team to play at a non-neutral site, your Cavers overcame a 21 point deficit at halftime to win 42-31.

The first CIF Championship since 1969. The SDHS students, staff, school administration, and fans helped raise \$22K in one week to help pay for the trip to Colfax.

Cavers Basketball

During the playoffs, your Cavers defeated Sweetwater HS by one point to advance to the SD CIF Div. 3 Championship vs. Valhalla HS. That game was played on Feb 21st, and your Cavers were victorious with a 75 to 56 win taking the Div. 3 Championship.

In the first round of the playoffs, your Cavers had a home game against San Luis Obispo HS. They won that game 53-34 and would then head to Victorville to take on Silverado HS for a CIF Regional Game.

The Cavers took the game into overtime, but a loss to Silverado HS 72-67 ended their season. Congratulations to the Cavers Basketball team for winning another league championship.

Cavers Girls Soccer

I'm not done, your SDHS Cavers Girls Soccer team played Serra HS and won 1-0 to take the CIF Div 3 League Championship.

They would have to travel and take on Oak Hills HS in a CIF Regional Game. Your lady Cavers took the game into overtime but loss 2-1 that ended their season.

The 4th annual Meb Keflezighi Invitational track meet was held at Balboa Stadium on March 9th.

Among the people honored was Meb's high school coach, Ed Ramos, who also coached Olympian Marc Davis.

Also honored is the Mickey's Missiles Track Club founded in 1965 by Audrey "Mickey" Patterson who was the first African-American Olympic medalist, the club features Olympian Jackie Thompson in the white.

Caver's Raiden Hunter is Audrey Patterson's grandson and he competed in multiple events including the 100-meter dash which was won by Orange Glen's Moray Steward.

The girls long jump winner was San Diego High freshman Charlize James with a jump of sixteen feet and three inches.

Caver's Sonia Redon won the 100-meter hurdle with a meet record time of 15:02 seconds.

Historian's Report

Did you know?

1919 was a year of many challenges and changes throughout the U.S., which impacted San Diego and San Diego High School students and families.

World War I ended on June 28 when the Treaty of Versailles was signed. On June 4,

The United States Congress approved the 19th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution, which guaranteed woman rights and suffrage.

Various Race Riots happened throughout the South as Blacks were in the pursuit of Freedom, equity, and equality during the time of Jim Crow. San Diego was not free from discriminatory practices, however, People of African descent and of other racial groups attended San Diego High School as this was the main and only public H.S. in San Diego.

Prior to 1919, there were talks of forming an R.O.T.C.- Reserve Officers' Training Corps. On or about February 1, 1919, the S.D.H.S. unit was formed officially.

During the second semester of the program, there was an increase of one hundred men within the first week.

The captain of the Corp. was Walter Frantz, who trained and led these students to become trained soldiers.
